Latitude End of Life

Added April 20, 2020

Genesys provides software updates for 18 months from the date of the release of the product version. With the release of Latitude 10.0 SU 9 in February 2019, SU7 and earlier releases have reached beyond their standard support expiration date. Genesys recommends that current Latitude 10.0 customers update to the latest Latitude 10.0 Service Release.

Account Analysis Conditions

The Account Analysis query tool in 10.0 SU 9 includes the new "Needs Review" condition to allow querying accounts with arrangements that have active payments that need reviewed.

Custodian

Custodian 10.0 SU 9 includes the following changes:

- Added "Evaluate Arrangements" task, which evaluates payment arrangements as follows:
 - o If a non-linked account is in queue level 998 or 999, the stored procedure places the account's PCCs, PDCs, and promises on hold.
 - o If an account has pending post-dated credit cards or checks, the stored procedure updates the queue level and status accordingly.
- Removed the following tasks and moved the functionality to the new "Evaluate Arrangements" task:
 - Set Inactive Closed Credit Cards
 - Set Inactive Closed Post Dated Checks
 - Set Inactive Closed Promises
 - Review PCCs
 - o Review PDCs

Installation and Configuration

Installation and configuration for Latitude 10.0 SU 9 includes the following new features:

- Updated PVGConverter tool to include creation of wallet records.
- If you upgrade from a Latitude version earlier than SU 9 to SU 9 or later, there is a utility program that you need to run **one time only**. For more information, see "Run Latitude.Utilities.DataFix.exe for SU 9 or Later" in the *Latitude Installation and Configuration Guide*.

Invoices

Invoices 10.0 SU 9 added preview, export and print invoice options to the **Invoice Options** dialog box for a specific or group of customers.

Latitude

Latitude 10.0 SU 9 includes the following new features and changes.

Addresses

Added the **Choose Bank Accounts to Sync Address Change** dialog box for syncing bank account addresses when modifying a debtor's or co-debtor's address. This dialog box also appears when modifying an address for an ACH wallet item.

Interest

Added the Interest Accrual Tracking panel for viewing accrued interest for an account.

Letters

- Added ability to modify pending letters using Microsoft Word to the Account Letters window.
 You can use this feature if your organization enabled the Merge Using Microsoft Word permission and you have Microsoft Word installed.
- Changed the format for saving letter images from RTF to PDF to save space.

Payment arrangements

- Added ability to change the check number for an active ACH payment in an arrangement in the Change Wallet Item dialog box.
- Added ability to change the payment instrument for multiple payments in the **Arrangements** panel.
- Added ability to select a payment instrument from the wallet on the **Select Payment Type** page in the **Enter New Arrangements** window.
- Added ability to view payment arrangements for linked accounts in the **Arrangements** panel.
- Added ability to add a payment to an arrangement in the Payment Arrangement Wizard.
- Added ability to renegotiate a payment arrangement in the Payment Arrangement Wizard.
- Changed the functionality for making up a declined payment in the **Arrangements** panel so that it doesn't ask whether you want to add or reuse a wallet item. Instead, it uses the existing payment instrument.
- Changed the functionality for real-time credit card processing in the **Arrangements** panel to either post transactions immediately or save them in a batch for posting later, depending on how your organization set the **Process Real-time Credit Card Transactions** permission.
- Added an option to the Select Settlement Arrangement and the Calculate Arrangements pages
 to allow you to calculate an arrangement on demand. If you have the appropriate permissions,
 you can calculate an arrangement on demand. If you don't have the appropriate permissions,
 Latitude calculates the arrangement as you change values in the arrangement, which decreases
 performance.
- Removed ability to add the remaining amount due (deficit) as a trailing payment from the
 Review Payment Arrangement page when tweaking an arrangement. Instead, Latitude adjusts the last payment amount accordingly.

Payment instruments

- Changed the process for adding payment instruments to the wallet in the Add Payment Instrument dialog box.
- Added ability to look up a payment instrument in the **Look up Payment Instrument** dialog box that is available during the current Latitude session only.
- Added ability to delete a payment instrument in the Wallet Maintenance dialog box.
- Added ability to change the address for a payment instrument in the Payment Instrument Contact dialog box.

Permissions

- Removed Access Promises permission as Latitude no longer requires it.
- Added "Default_AccountWithAIM" option to the Account View Customer Code Override Policy
 permission for displaying AIM details on the Account page in Web Access.
- Added "Post Real Time Credit Card transactions processed from the Arrangements panel" policy
 to Enable Real Time Credit Card Processing permission for specifying whether to post credit
 card transactions to debtor accounts immediately or save them to a batch file for processing
 later.
- Added Merge Using Microsoft Word permission for specifying whether users can modify pending letters in Latitude and letter templates in Letter Console using Microsoft Word. You must have Microsoft Word installed to use this feature.
- Added Add Payments permission for specifying whether users can add payments to nonsettlement payment arrangements.
- Added **Add Payment Instruments** permission for specifying whether users can add payment instruments to a person's wallet.
- Added Auto Calculate permission for specifying whether the system calculates arrangements as
 a user change values or whether the user notifies the system when to calculate the
 arrangement.
- Added Delete Payment Instruments permission for specifying whether users can delete payment instruments from a person's wallet.
- Added Edit Payment Instruments permission for specifying whether users can modify payment instrument addresses.
- Added Look up Payment Instruments permission for specifying whether users can look up payment instruments that are available during the current Latitude session only.
- Added **Use Payment Instruments** permission for specifying whether users can select a payment instrument in a person's wallet to use in a payment arrangement.

Queue levels

 Added queue level 014 - Incomplete Link Arrangement for linked arrangements that don't contain all the linked accounts. Changed description of queue level 019 from "Bounced Check (NSF), still has PDCs pending" to "Bounced Check (NSF), with PDCs pending."

Status codes

Added status code **ILA - Incomplete Link Arrangement** for linked arrangements that don't contain all the linked accounts.

System codes

Added Letter Type dialog box for maintaining user-defined letter types for Letter Console.

Letter Console

Letter Console 10.0 SU 9 includes the following changes:

- Renamed the **Download for Editing** button to **Download** on the **Letter Pool** tab.
- Renamed the Upload Edited Template button to Upload on the Letter Pool tab.
- When downloading or uploading letters, the file type defaults to ".doc" and both default to the same folder.
- Added letter code to the default file names for downloaded letters. Previously, the default file name only included the letter ID.
- Added an Edit button to the Letter Pool tab. This button is only available if your organization
 enabled the Merge Using Microsoft Word permission in Latitude. Latitude by Genesys added
 this button to restore the ability to open letter templates directly in Microsoft Word without
 having to use the download and upload feature. For more information about the new
 permission, see the Latitude documentation.
- When clicking the **Download Merge Fields** button on the **Letter Pool** tab, the output file name defaults to "MergeFields.[Letter Console Version].doc".
- Changed the bank account address fields to populate with the wallet contact information for NITD letters.

AIM 10.0 SU 8 includes the following new features for complaints and disputes:

Complaints

- Added Send Complaint Information check box to the Exporting tab in the Options window for including complaint records in the placement file that AIM sends to outside collection agencies and attorneys.
- Added Do Not Recall Accounts Receiving Complaints check box to the General tab in the
 Agencies/Attorneys pane for specifying whether the outside collection agency or attorney
 works accounts that have complaints. If they do work accounts that have complaints, AIM sends
 the accounts to the agency or attorney. If they don't work accounts that have complaints, AIM
 recalls the accounts from the agency or attorney automatically.
- Added "Complaints Export File" layout for exporting complaint records.
- Added "Placement Export File Complaints Record" layout for placing accounts that have complaint records with outside collection agencies or attorneys.
- Added "Complaints Import File" layout for importing complaint records received from outside collection agencies and attorneys holding the accounts.

Disputes

- Added Send Dispute Information check box to the Exporting tab in the Options window for including dispute records in the placement file that AIM sends to outside collection agencies and attorneys.
- Added Do Not Recall Accounts Receiving Disputes check box to the General tab in the
 Agencies/Attorneys pane for specifying whether the outside collection agency or attorney
 works accounts in dispute. If they do work accounts in dispute, AIM sends the accounts to the
 agency or attorney. If they don't work accounts in dispute, AIM recalls the accounts from the
 agency or attorney automatically.
- Added "Disputes Export File" layout for exporting dispute records.
- Added "Placement Export File Disputes Record" layout for placing accounts that have dispute records with outside collection agencies or attorneys.
- Added "Disputes Import File" layout for importing dispute records received from outside collection agencies and attorneys holding the accounts.

AIM Receiver Manager

AIM Receiver Manager 10.0 SU 8 includes the following new features:

 Added Complaint (CCPT) option to the Process tab in the Client Configuration window for importing complaints. Added Complaint (ACPT) option to the Process tab in the Client Configuration window for exporting complaints.

 Payments permission.
- Changed the limit for the **Maximum Payments** policy in the **Add Credit Card Payments** permission to 250. When upgrading to Latitude 10.0 SU 8, ensure that this value is greater than 0 (zero) or you cannot create a payment arrangement.
- Removed Allow check deposit prior to the current date policy from the Create PDCs permission.
- Changed the limit for the **Maximum Checks** policy in the **Create PDCs** permission to 250. When upgrading to Latitude 10.0 SU 8, ensure that this value is greater than 0 (zero) or you cannot create a payment arrangement.
- Changed the limit for the **Maximum Promises** policy in the **Create Promises** permission to 250. When upgrading to Latitude 10.0 SU 8, ensure that this value is greater than 0 (zero) or you cannot create a payment arrangement.
- Added **Enter Check Information** permission for specifying whether users can provide checking or savings account information when creating a payment arrangement.
- Added **Enter Credit Card Information** permission for specifying whether users can provide credit card information when creating a payment arrangement.

Account Analysis Conditions

The Account Analysis query tool in Latitude 10.0 SU 7 includes the following new conditions for querying accounts based on credit reporting criteria:

- Added "cbrDataPaidByInsurance" condition to allow querying medical accounts that insurance paid.
- Added "cbrDataPendingExceptionDtlv" condition to allow querying accounts based on credit reporting exceptions.

Credit Bureau Reporting Wizard

Credit Bureau Reporting Wizard 10.0 SU 7 includes the following new exceptions for reporting accounts to the credit bureaus:

- Added "InvalidDOB" exception. If an authorized account user's date of birth is missing or a
 responsible party's SSN and date of birth are both missing, the account doesn't report to the
 credit bureaus.
- Added "InvalidOriginalLoanAmount" exception. If the original loan amount is missing, the account doesn't report to the credit bureaus.
- Added "MedicalWithin180Days" exception. If an account has a medical creditor classification and is less than 180 days past the delinquency date, the account doesn't report to the credit bureaus.
